

Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP) Household Income Guidance

Updated May 16, 2023

If your household annual income is less than or equal to the amount described below for your county, then you are likely eligible for the state [Weatherization Assistance Program \(WAP\)](#), which offers free weatherization services. While you are still permitted to apply for WRAP, we encourage you to look into WAP first to maximize your potential benefits.

If your household income is higher than that amount, you are still permitted to apply for WRAP (subject to funding availability), but you may be eligible for fewer grant incentives.
